The platform also serves as a space for the dissemination of experiences and educational programs related to sustainability.



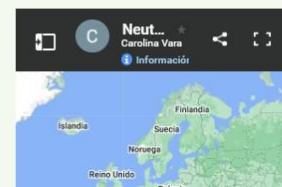

## COMPETENCIES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP.

Schools, educational centers and organizations who join the network will be helped to connect with relevant partners to:

- their students become agents of change and sustainability for a Carbon neutral future
- share their climate action experiences with other European schools;
- find inspiration and support on how to address climate issues that are relevant to your curriculum, your school, and your community;

The only requirement to be part of the network is to:

- Be a school or any educational entity interested in the Climate Action and Sustainability.

- Design/implementation of an experience/service for climate action in the educational center (past, present or future)

## IMPLEMENTATION PROCESS OF THE PLATFORM AND THE NETWORK

- Preparation of informative content for the online Platform
- Creation of the platform (linked on the project website) in the 5 languages of the project, including English
- DISSEMINATION process developed by the educational centers of the project partnership and their collaborating educational centers to inform about it and achieve the adhesion of Schools:
  - EMAILING
  - SOCIAL NETWORKS
  - MEETINGS, ETC.
- UPDATING the platform content
- DINAMYZATION of the platform

## CONTENT OF THE PLATFORM

### 1. Educational Resources

Resources on sustainability and climate change, including:

- a) References or links to guides, educational videos, publications, portals, games, etc.
- b) Educational resources and materials generated by the NEUTRAL-SCHOOLS project

### 2. Projects and Challenges

Platform to create and participate in collaborative projects between schools or launch challenges, with prizes and recognitions (such as the “C-Neutral School” label):

a) Design/implementation of an experience/service for climate action in the educational center (past, present or future)

b) Challenges to reduce the carbon footprint

### 3. Forums and Communities

- Discussion spaces where teachers and students can share ideas, experiences and questions.
- Thematic groups on various aspects of sustainability (energy, recycling, sustainable mobility, energy efficiency, etc.).
- Collaboration space to find partners and collaborators in inter-school projects.
- Space for schools to request information about possible funds to request for specific projects.

### 4. Events

- Calendar of virtual and in-person events related to climate change and sustainability.

### 5. Success Stories

- Section dedicated to highlighting success stories from participating schools or others.
- Interviews and inspiring articles about successful projects.

### 6. Interactive Map

**Which schools can join the Network?**

All pre-school, primary and secondary schools, including technical or vocational schools and other entities that are interested in becoming agents of change and sustainability for a carbon-neutral future.



**REGISTRATION**
